As the first university in the country to offer Recovery Housing, Rutgers University is an innovator in offering students in recovery an opportunity for a fulfilling college residential experience free from the distractions of drugs and alcohol. Since 1988, Rutgers has maintained a nationally recognized counseling program for students facing alcohol and drug problems. Hundreds of students have lived in on-campus Recovery Housing; they experienced academic success and graduated. House members often work, intern, study abroad and/or perform volunteer work while at Rutgers. Recovery House Alumni keep strong ties with the house and university, as over 125 people attended the 25th year reunion in 2008. Many alumni have gone on to earn their MAs, MSWs, MBAs, JDs, and PhDs.

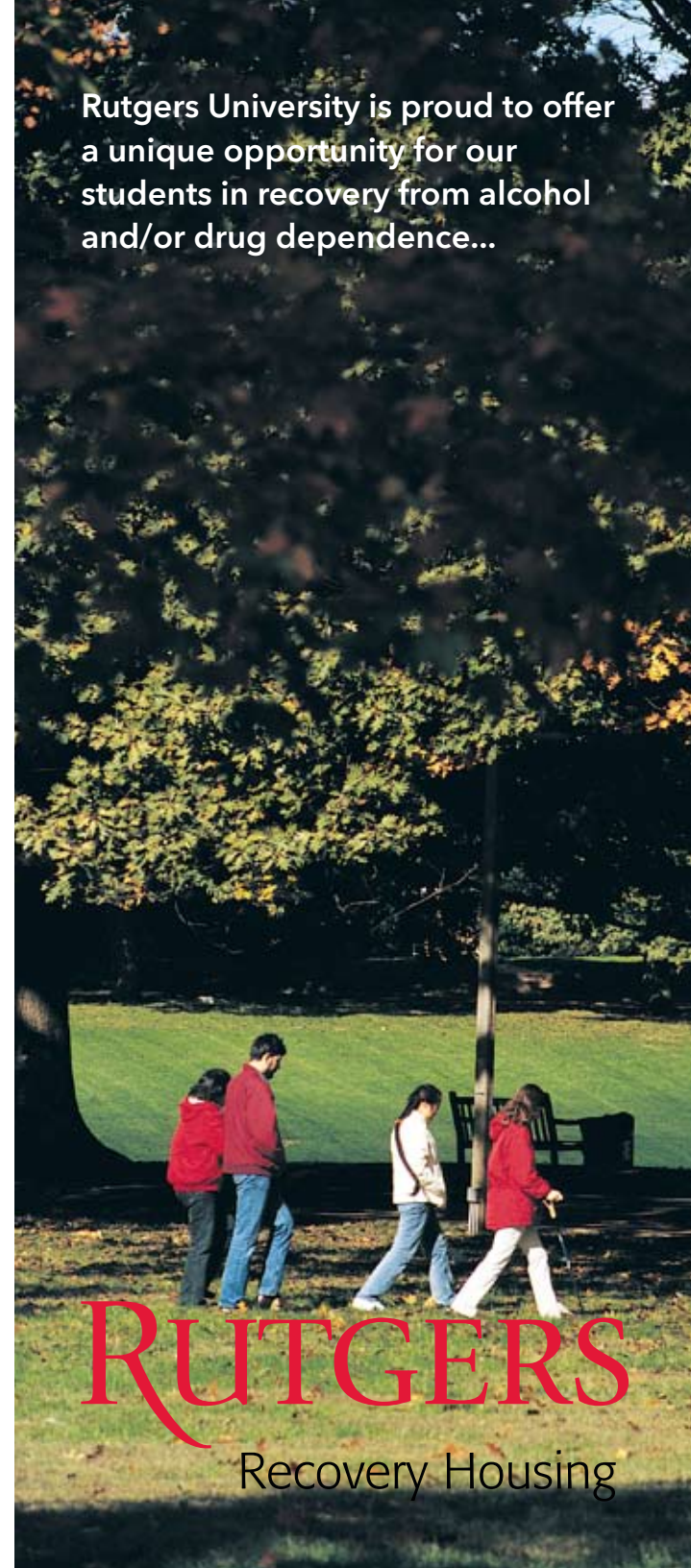
